Membership Application



Information for the Applicant:

As an applicant for membership in the Pillars of Enoch Widows Sons Chapter there are qualifications, code of conduct, financial and other requirements you need to be aware of. Please read this document in its entirety and sign at bottom.

Qualifications:

Applicants for full patch membership in the Pillars of Enoch Chapter must be a Master Mason who is in good standing with a lodge recognized by the Grand Lodge of the Most Ancient and Honorable Society of Free and Accepted Masons for the State of New Jersey and retain that good standing during his membership. EA & FC candidates can be accepted as applicants but must complete the MM Examination before full patch membership will be considered. You must own a legally registered and insured motorcycle capable of highway speeds(500cc or better), kept in safe working order and hold a valid driver's license with motorcycle endorsement.

Hangout Period:

Just like your Masonic Lodge, potential members are investigated and balloted on. There is no guarantee of membership therefore participation and good relations with the entire membership is necessary. Peace and harmony is of paramount importance to the chapter, therefore potentially disruptive influences will be shunned. No one expects to become best friends overnight but disagreements or personality conflicts must be settled peacefully.

The Hangout period will last three months. During this period you will be required to attend at least three rides and/or club events. This period may not exceed three months unless discussed and voted on by the membership due to special circumstances. This period allows the membership to evaluate your riding skills and suitability for membership.

Probationary Membership:

Having completed the hangout period successfully you will be voted on as a probationary member. If successful you will be required to wear a probation patch. This period will last at least three months and no longer than twelve months. At this time the Probationary Member will be presented with a Patch set containing 1 Large Widow patch, 1 Small Widow Patch, 1 Masonic riders bottom rocker 1 probation patch and directed how to have them installed on his vest. Again you are required to attend at least three rides and/or club events. You will not have voting privileges.

Full Membership:

Successfully completing the probation period a ballot will be spread for full membership. Full patch membership status may only be granted by a unanimous secret ballot by the members present during a regular monthly meeting and only after the probationary member has fulfilled his obligations within the specified time period. A full patch member will receive a full set of patches, have full rights of membership and be able to hold office. Cost of patches are always the members responsibility.

Conduct:

We are Masons first. Every member of the Pillars of Enoch Chapter will conduct themselves as a Master Mason at all times, ride in a safe manner at all times, follow directions given by the Road Captain/s and keep your passions in due bounds with all mankind especially your brothers. Alcohol is permitted at many events and consumption should be within reason. Impaired riding and drug use are prohibited.

Costs:

Club dues are \$25 annually and payable in January of each year. Members elected to probationary status in the middle of the year pay \$10 to the state and \$1.25 to the chapter for each month left in the current year.

You are expected to purchase a black leather vest to be worn at all club events adding your patches when earned. A full patch set runs approximately \$150 and is your responsibility. The oval widow patches and rockers are always considered property of the Widows Sons Masonic Riders Assoc. and/or Pillars of Enoch Chapter and must be surrendered on resignation or expulsion.

Ladies and Families:

Ladies/wives are always welcome at our rides and events whether they ride themselves or come two up and are only excluded at club meetings. It will be your responsibility to assure they ride safely and follow Road Captain directions.

Children are typically welcome at open social and charity events. Use your discretion if a babysitter is not an option.
